



Wild Rivers/Soak City Water Park

On Saturday, September 4, 2010, the Troop will be making a day trip to either Knott's Soak City in Chula Vista or Wild Rivers Water Park in Irvine! We have the opportunity to go to Soak City for less than Wild Rivers, but it will be up to you! We need to have a final decision on which park by next week's meeting (August 17).

The water park trip has been very a popular trip in the past, but we have heard that some of you are looking for a change in venue (and rides). Soak City cost is \$3 less for those 10 and above, but \$4 more for siblings under 10 years old.

Either way, the trip is open to registered Scouts and their families. The Soak City cost for each registered Scout is \$14. Non-scouts are \$24 per person.

We will carpool to the event from the church. Complete uniforms will be required for the event for scouts. No uniform, no trip. Both parks open at 10:00 AM and closes at 6:00 PM. We will meet at 08:45 AM for a 09:00 AM departure from the church. We should arrive back at the church at around 7:00 PM. We will need drivers, but only those drivers scheduled to take Scouts outside of their own family will receive mileage and parking reimbursement (round trip drivers only). Important note: if a non-Scout minor family member attends the event, a parent or guardian must also be present.

The troop will purchase the tickets as a single group, so it is important that your money is in on time. All ticket purchase money is due with the permission slip. Any permission slips turned in after the due date cannot be accepted, and that Scout or family will be responsible for obtaining their own tickets.

For Wild Rivers you may bring your own lunch (however, it cannot be brought into the park – lockers are available outside the gate, or we may get one large group locker) or you may purchase food at the park. Water bottles may be brought into the park. For Soak City there is a lunch deal (buffet!) for \$7.75.

Come and have a great day at the water park, whichever one it is!

This authorization is given pursuant to the provisions of Section 25.8 of the Civil Code of California.

This authorization shall remain in effect so long as my (our) son is a registered Boy Scout unless sooner revoked in writing delivered to said agent(s).
